

TOPSHAM WALKING TOUR

Use this guide to explore some of the highlights of Topsham. The route is along pavements and is mostly flat with a short descent (gradient upon return).

Upon leaving the Bowling Club, turn right towards Fore Street. Then turn left through the main shopping area. Pass The Salutation Inn on your right and bear right as the road bends. Facing St Margaret's Church, take the path to the left of the church to gain a stunning view across the River Exe.



Retrace your steps turning right to continue along Fore Street, passing The Globe Hotel on your left as the road bends and descends towards Topsham Quay.



Beware traffic as you cross the mini-roundabout.

(Can you resist the temptation to explore Quay Antique Centre?)



Those wishing to venture a little further can continue along the road enjoying views of the river on your right and Shell House on the left.

A few more paces and you reach Topsham Museum, also on your left (*worth a visit if you have time to learn about Topsham's fascinating history; admission is FREE. Open most afternoons during the Summer*).



Further along the road you can see Dutch-style houses (so called as they were built from bricks used as ballast by ships returning from trading with the Netherlands).



Continue along the road to gain views down the river toward Exmouth. The narrow path on the left is known as Goat Walk.



Retrace your steps to return to the hospitality of

Topsham Bowling Club.
